Guidelines for abstract submission

- 1. Abstracts must be submitted until June 30th, 2021
- 2. Abstracts can be submitted via the online Abstract Submission Form only. Abstracts sent by fax or email will not be accepted.
- 3. All abstracts must be submitted in English.
- 4. Authors must choose one thematic field from the following lists that most closely describes the content of their submission:
 - Experimental Sepsis / COVID-19 Research
 - Clinical Sepsis / COVID-19 Research Diagnostics
 - Clinical Sepsis / COVID-19 Research Therapy
 - Sepsis / COVID-19 Prevention & Vaccination
 - Pediatric Sepsis / COVID-19 Research
 - Sepsis / COVID-19 Long Term Outcome
- 5. The abstract text is limited to **2.500 characters**. The 2.500 character limit includes punctuation and spacing. The abstract should be structured as follows:
 - Title
 - Introduction
 - Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- 6. When uploading figures and tables, the text should be reduced accordingly. Tables and figures should be in high resolution (300 dpi) in jpg, tif, eps or png format with a width of at least 85 mm.
- 7. The presenting author is the first author of the abstract.
- 8. If your abstract is accepted, you will present it during a poster session. In case your abstract fits thematically in one of the main congress sessions, you will be invited to a free oral presentation as well.
- 9. The corresponding authors will be informed by the middle of July 2021 via e-mail if their abstracts have been accepted.
- 10. Submitting an abstract does not replace the registration as a congress participant. The presenting author must additionally register for congress participation via the online registration form.
- 11. All accepted abstracts will be published in the abstract supplement of the Journal "Infection".
